Our 'Ready for Anything' themed week will form a big part of our Year 6 Transition Project, where we will be preparing the children for secondary school. The week will provide them with a range of fun and rewarding experiences as well as helping them to face challenges, develop skills and recognise their strengths as they move forward to the next stage in their lives.

We plan to include the following activities:

- **London:** a fun-packed day out where we will experience the contrast of life in the capital, explore museums and visit key landmarks that link to our history topic;
- **Moors Valley:** a range of exciting outdoor challenges that will include working as a team, high ropes and map reading;
